e-dermatology provides online dermatology education for specialist trainees in dermatology, associate specialists, general practitioners and dermatology nurses. It is being produced by the British Association of Dermatologists in collaboration with e-Learning for Healthcare.

The content is based on the Joint Royal Colleges of Physicians Training Board curriculum for specialist training in dermatology (available at www.jrcptb.org.uk). The sessions are interactive with self-assessment components.
